THE MAIN FACTORS (M-FACTORS)/ KEY POINTS IN DELHI ASSEMBLY ELECTIONS – 2025

- 1. Inflation
- 2. Arrest of Sri. Arvind Kejriwal and others ministers in Delhi government (AAP Govt).
- 3. Welfare schemes announced by all the parties (BJP, AAP and INC).
- 4. Mohalla clinics and infrastructure for educational institutions.
- 5. Free bus service for women and free power for households.
- 6. Pollution effect in Delhi.
- 7. BJP failed to announce (or) project a person as Chief Minister for Delhi.
- 8. Damaged street roads and drainage problems.
- 9. Caste/Religion wise division of voters among parties.
- 10. Division of women voters is clearly visible in Assembly elections 2025 in Delhi. It will damage AAP up to certain extent only.
- 11. If INC will secure more than 9.5% of vote share it will damage AAP and if INC will secure/limited less than 9% of vote share than AAP will form the government.
- 12. The final result of AAP and BJP will depend on the political and poll management by both the parties.
- 13. Split noticed in slum area voting in between BJP and AAP.
- 14. Sri. Aravind Kejriwal, Smt. Atishi and Sri. Manish sisodia belongs to APP are facing keen contest in their respective assembly constituency.
- 15. Middle class voting will decide the final result of Delhi assembly elections.






